

1910's corset

Measurements:

- Front length – 16 ½"
- Side length – 20"
- Back length – 18"
- Waist – 14 ¼" (29" total with no lacing gap)
- Top edge - 16 ¾" (33 1/2" total, NLG)
- Hips – 22 1/2" (45" total, NLG)

Body panels (greatest height and width for each piece):

- center front – 4" x 16 ½" (includes seam allowance for width only on all pieces)
- front side top – 5" x 4 ¾"
- front side bottom – 8 ½" x 15 ½"
- side – 7" x 20"
- center-back – 7 ½" x 19"

Bone lengths:

1. 11" busk (starts 1" below top edge)
2. has ¼" casing next to it, but no bones
3. two ¼" bones - 11" long (1" below top)
4. two ¼" bones – 10 ½" long (1" below top)
5. two ¼" bones – 10 ½" long (¾" below top)
6. one ½" bone – 11" long (1" below top)
7. one ½" bone – 13 ½" long (½" below top)
8. two ¼" bones - 14 ½" long (½" below top)
9. one ¼" bone – 15 ½" long (¼" below top)
10. one 3/8" bone – 15 ½" long (¼" below top)

Supplies

Boning:

- busk: 11"
- ½" bones: 2 @ 11", 2 @ 13.5"
- ¼" bones: 8 @ 10.5", 4 @ 11", 4 @ 14.5", 4 @ 15.5"

Boning casings (not including seam allowance):

- 1" wide for busk strip (33" total)
- 1 ¼" wide for lacing strip (1 yd total)
- 7/8" wide for double bones (4 ¼ yards total)
- ¾" wide for single bones 76.5 (2 ¼ yards total)

Misc. Supplies:

- 21 eyelets, 13/16" apart (42 total)
- stay tape – 1" wide x 13" long (3/4 yard total)
- 2" wide decorative lace – 18" long (1 yd total)
- ¼" Edge binding – cut on straight grain - 25" bottom, 18" top (2 ½ yards total)
- two ½" hook and eyes
- four 1 ¼" woven garter straps (2 yds total?)
- four garter clips and slides
- herringbone coutil – 1 yard of 54" wide
- two laces at 3 ½ yards each
